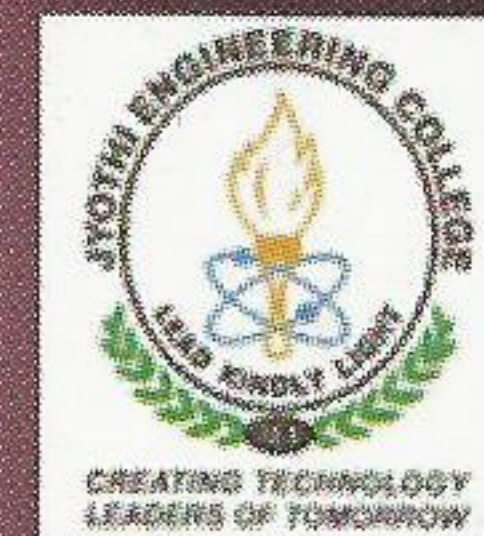

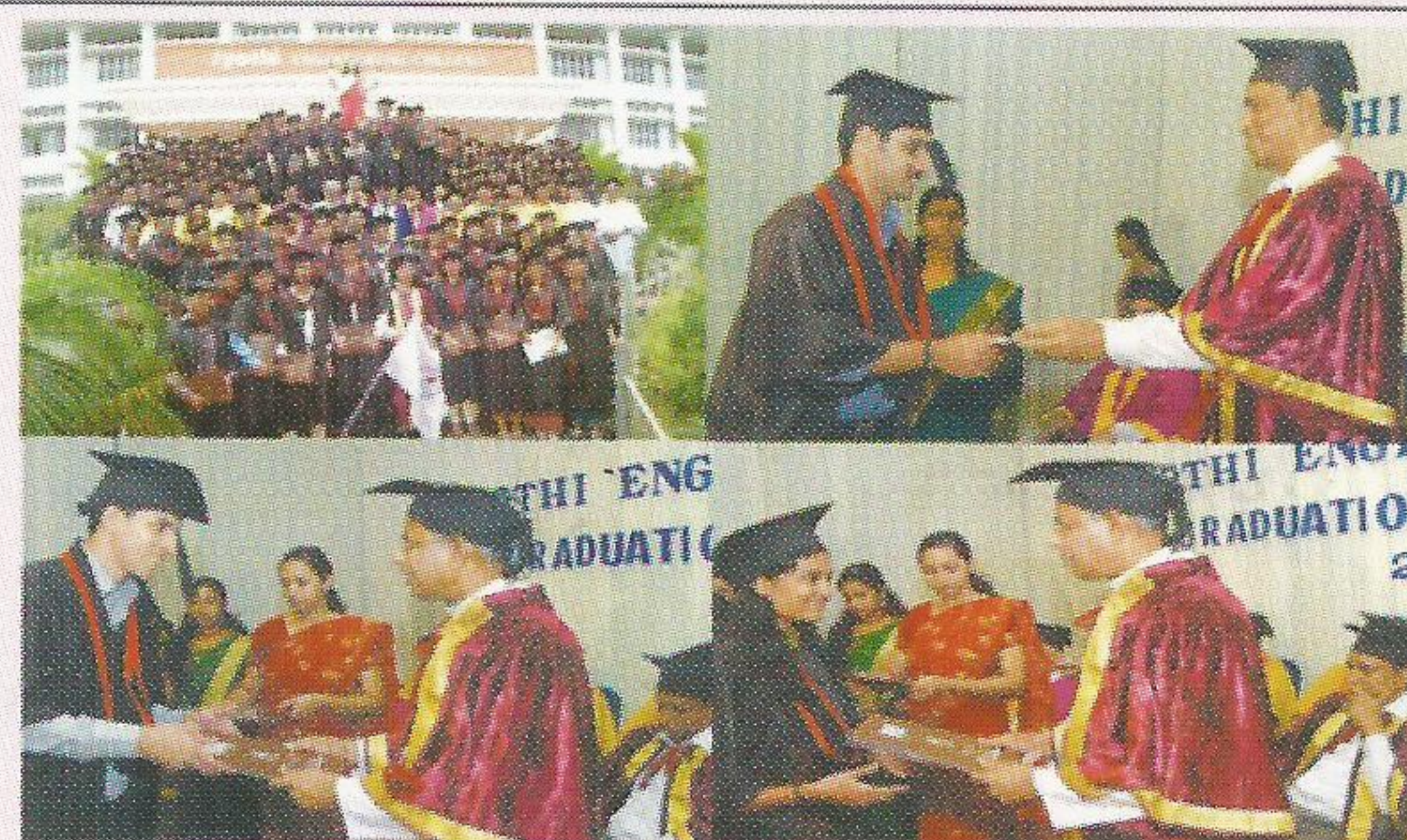

Blood Donors Forum : Blood Donors Forum of JEC conducted a blood donation camp on 5th July 2011 in connection with the World

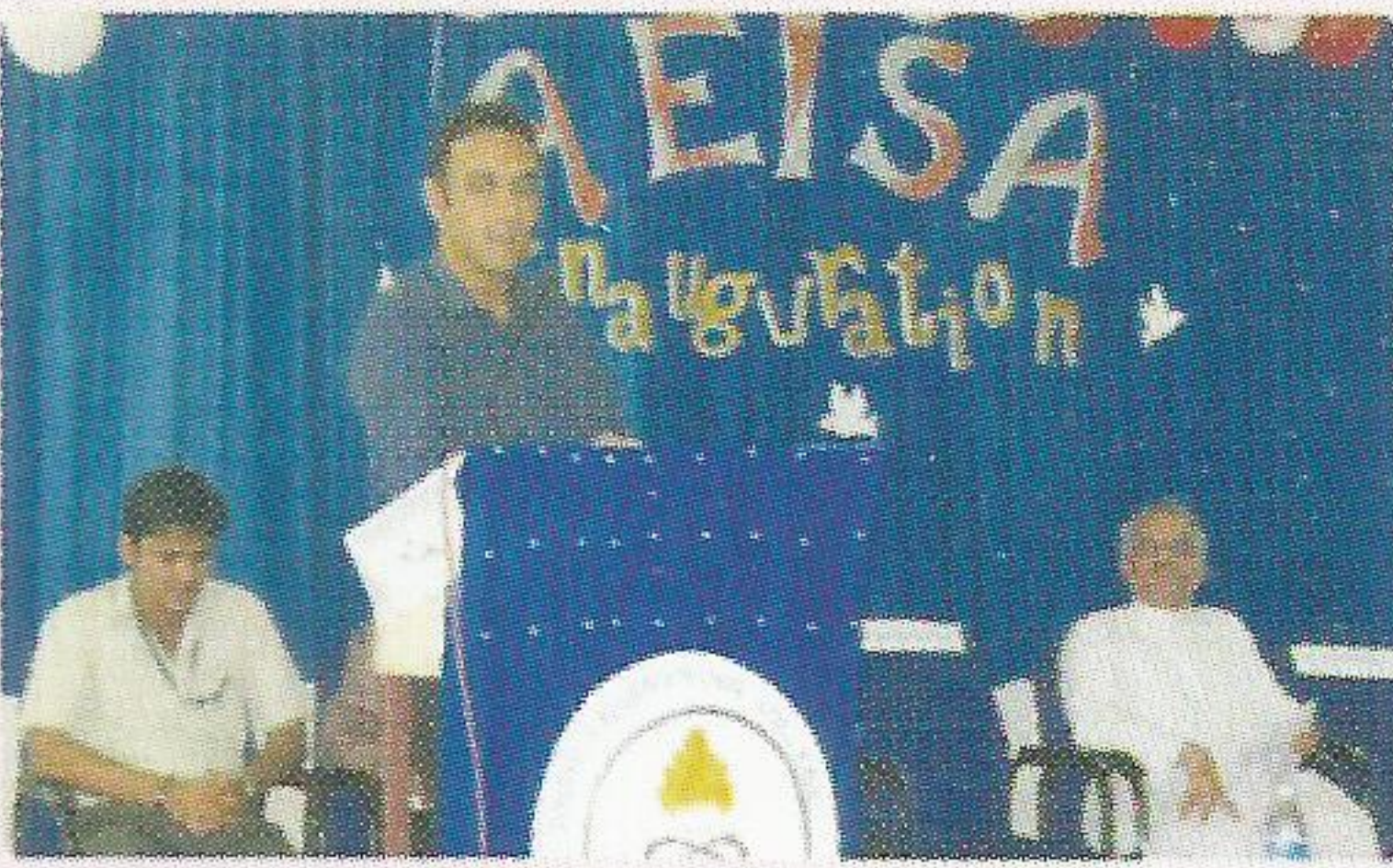


Blood Donation day, 66 members including staff & students of the college donated their blood. A team of staff from Jubilee Mission Medical College led the camp.

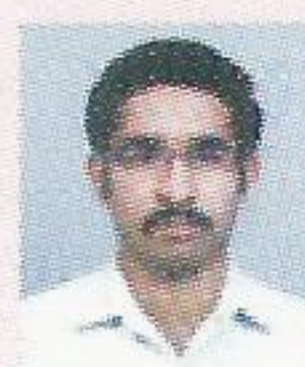
