- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt

- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation
- Physical or psychological humiliation

Functions

- To appraise the students about the contents of the anti-ragging act and to advise them not to involve in the incidents of ragging.
- Making frequent visits in the campus to prevent any acts of ragging.
- Visiting class rooms and to explain to the students about the severe punishments and the Consequences likely to be imposed as per the act.
- Accompanying the students in the college buses at the end of the day's work.
- Preparation of Charts and Banners depicting the seriousness of actions to be taken in case of any ragging incident and to give wide publicity by displaying those banners at salient locations

Punishment those found guilty

As per the UGC norms any student or group of students found guilty of ragging shall be liable to one or more of the following punishment

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
2. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
4. Withholding results
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
6. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel
7. Cancellation of admission

8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from I to 4 semesters
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period
10. Fine ranging between Rupees 25,000/- and Rupees 1 lakh
11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

College has taken various precautions to prevent ragging and ensures 100% no ragging. Some of them are :

- Formed an Anti- Ragging Committee consisting of senior faculty members, senior Technical staff, and senior administrative officer and headed by HoD of one of the Department.
- Committee has taken steps and allotted duties to all the staff members at almost all areas in the college
- Many awareness programmes about Anti-Ragging were organised by the Anti-Ragging Committee.
- Wide canvassing about anti-ragging, is being done in the forms of Flexes, Posters and Boards in college premises and surrounding areas where there is a chance of ragging.

Measures or preventive action taken at institution level

- Places inside the campus like hostels and canteen are identified which are prone to ragging
- Separate rooms in hostel are identified and allocated to the new entrants of the college and special care is taken about them
- Sign boards and mobile numbers of anti-ragging committee members are put at important places in the campus and at the website to report any ragging issues by students.

Vice Principal Prof. Ratnam sir delivers welcome to all. Principal on his presidential speech mentioned the importance of the anti-ragging committee. He told that, as ragging is a criminal offense, we are bounded to give awareness about the seriousness of ragging among all students. Also even sharp look against junior students by the seniors will include in the list of ragging offense. Small talks may lead to serious issues and may result in a clash. So, it is very important to observe the students by all the faculties to avoid any disputes among students. Principal shared his experience that, in some cases, the students may report a fake complaint against his rival for taking action up on him. So, it is very important to verify whether the given complaint is genuine or not. Principle opines that it will be better to give minimum interaction for first-year students with senior students. The principal informed to conduct an effective anti-ragging seminar to all third semester during August first week.

After the presidential talk of principal, open discussions were conducted. Convener of the anti-ragging cell, Dr. David .KJ express that, it is better to conduct surprise visit in the canteen, cafeteria, hostel, toilet, playground and even in the classrooms. He also told that observation should be there on the college bus also. Vice Principal Prof. Ratnam emphasizes the importance of anti-ragging awareness class and request to conduct this class immediately. Mr. Nidhan Johnson AP-BSM informs to publish more posters on the campus. The meeting came to an end at 3:40 pm by the vote of thanks of Assistant Administrator Er. Bobby Peter.
